New awards for graduate students

The opening of Pipe Partridge this year marks a major milestone in LMH's development programme, and indeed in the College's history. Our first new building for nearly 40 years is now a handsome reality, thanks to the generosity of so many of our alumni and other friends. The totals raised for the overall project are as follows:

In the last 5 years – the period of our first strategic plan - we have raised altogether £10.78 million in gifts and pledges, of which some £8.24 million has been received, and spent or invested for the benefit of the College and its current and future students. The new buildings have been our priority in recent years, but many have chosen also to support other areas, and also the general purposes of the College, all of which are so vitally important to the success of our academic community. We are sincerely grateful to all those whose names are listed in the pages that follow for their tremendous support. The commitment is all the more remarkable given that, in this period, we have experienced the most serious global economic downturn in living memory. The College has fulfilled practically all the goals set five years ago. Our thanks again to all those who have made this happen.



Next steps

The Three-Pillar Strategy – Sustaining Excellence



The longer-term effects of the economic crisis on higher education and on LMH in particular, have become clear very recently with huge cuts in central government funding for teaching, plus huge increases in tuition fees for undergraduates. We are determined to sustain excellence in teaching and research, to recruit the best

students, irrespective of their financial situation, and to provide the very best facilities possible, including the next phase of the new buildings - the completion of the project.

So we have developed a "Three-Pillar Strategy" for fundraising over the next five years: student support, teaching and research, and new buildings. The newly launched Annual Fund is progressing very well, with £70k raised in the first few weeks. It is aimed especially at supporting students and teaching. We are also making good progress towards the next phase of the new building project. Thanks to gifts from the Clore Duffield Foundation and other donors, £2.4m has been raised already towards the £7.0m needed. Finally, we will work to establish permanent funding for crucial teaching and research posts.

Year-Group Giving – the Arch Fund Programme

May 2008 saw the launch of the Arch Fund programme. This year-group initiative and brainchild of Jo Andrews (1974 PPE), was designed to encourage groups of alumni to come together with a joint gift. Furthermore, many first-time donors to the College were encouraged to collaborate and make a real difference to the project – some feeling they could not give much alone. 1974 collectively raised £10,000 which is now marked with a plaque on the Donors' Colonnade. Following this success, Dame Margaret Turner Warwick led 1943 to a £10,000 sum in June 2010. We are now working with groups from 1959, 1960, 1961 and 1970 and are extremely grateful to those leading these initiatives and to everyone who has supported their fund. 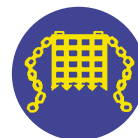
