LMH Oxford Summer Programmes – Scholarships Information

Lady Margaret Hall is delighted to offer a number of part-fee scholarships for exceptional students participating in the LMH Oxford Summer Programmes.

- Talbot Scholars will receive a 25% Programme Fee Scholarship.
- Wordsworth Scholars will receive a 50% Programme Fee Scholarship.

Scholars will have their Programme Fee reduced by the amount of the scholarship award but will be responsible for paying the remainder of the Programme Fee.

Eligibility:

Applicants must meet the usual minimum admissions requirements of the LMH Oxford Summer Programmes, which can be found here: [Application and Fees | Lady Margaret Hall](#). To be considered for a scholarship, applicants must also:

- Currently be enrolled and in good academic standing at a higher education institution anywhere in the world. Undergraduate or graduate students may apply.
- Have a Grade Point Average equivalent to 70% / 1st Class in the typical British grading system. For example, this would be 3.7/4.0 in the United States, or 90-95% in China, depending on the type of institution. - Apply directly to Lady Margaret Hall, and not through a third-party study abroad organisation or institutional partnership.

Application Process:

1. Apply to the Programme via the online Application Form **by an earlier deadline of 8th March 2026**, and respond “Yes” to the final question on the form, asking if you would like to be considered for a scholarship.
2. We will let you know whether you have been offered a place on the Programme, and ask you to secure your place by paying a 25% Programme Fee Deposit. We will also let you know whether you have been shortlisted for a scholarship, and if so we will request two further supporting documents to be sent to us **no later than 15th March 2026**:

- a. A copy of your up-to-date academic transcript **sent directly to us by your home institution**.
- b. An academic letter of recommendation **sent to us directly from a tutor** who has taught you as part of your current degree.

3. By 21st March 2026 all shortlisted students will be informed of the result of their scholarship application, and invited to secure their place (and, if successful, their scholarship) by signing an Enrolment Agreement and paying a 25% Programme Fee deposit within 14 days.
