LMH gained accreditation from the UK's Fairtrade Foundation in 2010. Fairtrade is about better prices, decent working conditions and fair terms for farmers and workers in the developing world. In line with LMH's commitment to equality, community, sustainability and offering choice to staff, students and visitors, the College intends to continue its commitment to Fairtrade. To do this the College will

- Make Fairtrade products available in all relevant retail outlets, where possible.
- Increase the opportunities to provide, use or sell Fairtrade products where possible.
- Increase the range of products available at those outlets over time
- Serve Fairtrade products at College meetings and events, where possible
- Increase the range of products available at those events
- Host events and campaigns to educate staff and students within the College, raising awareness and understanding of Fairtrade
- Use Domestic Committee, with JCR, MCR and SCR representation as a Steering Group for Fairtrade at LMH.
