

## FEES ARRANGEMENTS AND TERM DATES FOR VISITING STUDENTS 2022-2023

### Admissions policies

There is a deposit of **£500** payable per student on acceptance of the offer of a place. This will be counted against their tuition fees on arrival, but will be non-refundable if the student withdraws after having accepted their place.

Any withdrawal must take place before 30<sup>th</sup> June for students starting in Michaelmas term, and before 30<sup>th</sup> September for students starting in Hilary term. **Students withdrawing after these dates will be liable for full tuition and accommodation fees for the duration of the programme.**

**\*Students studying subjects in more than one rate:** in cases where a Visiting Student is studying across subject areas with different fee rates, the applicable fee rate shall be that which applies to the larger portion of their studies; in the case of two subjects equally weighted, the fee rate shall be that which applies to the subject that carries the higher fee; in the case of three subjects weighted equally, the fee rate shall be that which applies to the subject that carries the mid-level fee.

### Accommodation

The accommodation fees are listed in the table below; the options are as follows:

1. Term-time only accommodation: for this option, the date on which term ends is the date when students would normally be expected to move out of College accommodation.
2. Academic Year- accommodation: For full year students, this would include the Christmas and Easter vacation periods; for Hilary and Trinity students, this would include the Easter vacation only.
3. Alternatively, students may request to remain in College for shorter periods during the vacations by arrangement with the Bursary, towards the end of each term. This might not be in the student's term time room. Vacation residence is charged at a nightly rate, which is £29.88 for 2022-23.

The tuition fees are due in full by the Wednesday of first week in the student's start term (term dates are listed below). The accommodation fees are due in termly instalments by the Wednesday of first week each term. The relevant payment due dates are listed below:

### Domestic arrangements and living costs

Students may purchase the subsidised meals that are served in the College Dining Hall. During term time, breakfast, lunch and dinner are served Monday to Friday, and additionally brunch on Saturday and dinner on Sunday. The average spend per meal at lunch and dinner is about £4 (slightly less for breakfast). There is no catering pre-payment system at LMH. Students credit their College accounts on a pay-as-you-go basis and purchase meals in the Dining Hall using their University Card (our tills operate on a cashless system).

There are also small shared kitchens available for students who wish to prepare their own meals; students need to supply their own pots/pans and crockery, which can be purchased locally at reasonable prices.

Students have the option to request a bedding pack, which includes a pillow, pillowcase, duvet, duvet cover and bottom sheet. The cost of this is currently £25, which is normally billed to the student on arrival, but can also be billed to their sponsor on request.

Our term dates for 2022-2023 are shown below. Students are expected to stay for the full term and not leave early. In exceptional circumstances an early departure may be permitted but requires the approval of the Director of Visiting Students and the student's home institution.
