

## Application Requirements

To apply, complete **both** steps below:

1. **Online application form:** <https://app.onlinesurveys.jisc.ac.uk/s/oxford/lady-margaret-hall-visiting-student-programme-application-for-1>
2. **Submit supporting materials** via <https://portal.lmh.ox.ac.uk/url/VSupportingsupportingmaterials>

Your application will not be processed until all materials are submitted.

## Required Supporting Materials

### Supporting Statement Form

Must be completed online by a representative from your home institution (e.g., Academic Adviser or Study Abroad Advisor). Share this link with them:

### Academic Transcript

Submit via the supporting materials portal (by you or your institution).

### Two Academic References

- Written by tutors or advisors familiar with your work. They should comment on:
- Academic ability and qualifications
- Motivation and suitability for intensive study
- Ability to work in tutorials/small groups
- Resilience and adaptability
- Suggested length: approx. 500 words.

Submit via the supporting materials portal (by you or referees).

### Recent Academic Work

Academic work must be relevant to your chosen subject(s).

Please submit essays (max 2,000 words) or coursework, problem sheets, or tests demonstrating your ability. Extracts from longer work are allowed.

Submit:

- 2 pieces if applying for one subject area
- 1 piece per subject if applying for multiple subject areas

### English Language certification (if applicable)

If your first language is not English, you must meet Oxford's language requirements.

Exemption only applies if you have studied full-time in English for **2 years before applying** (supporting evidence required – submit via the supporting materials portal).

Otherwise, submit an approved test result (e.g., IELTS) via the supporting materials portal as per <https://www.ox.ac.uk/admissions/undergraduate/applying-to-oxford/english-language-requirements>.

## Tutorial selection advice

- Course details: <https://www.lmh.ox.ac.uk/prospective-students/visiting-students/subjects>.
- Seek approval from your academic advisor if required. Contact us for specific course content.
- Visiting students usually follow the same courses as LMH undergraduates. Some subjects may offer small classes instead of tutorials.
- Ensure you have the pre-requisite background knowledge for the courses you select.
- You may choose tutorial topics from up to 3 subject areas. For the best experience, select topics from 1–2 subject areas.
- Most students take 12 tutorials per term: 1 major (8 tutorials) and 1 minor (4 tutorials).
- Oxford runs on an annual lecture cycle; we will allocate your tutorial selections to the term in which they are offered.
- LMH does not award credits; this is the responsibility of your home institution. LMH provides a transcript listing courses, tutor names, and grades.
- The courses you list in your application will inform your programme of study at LMH (if offered a place), so please think carefully about your choices.

## Completing Tutorial Choices Section

- You can choose from up to 3 subject areas: select from the drop-down field, then list topics in order of preference.
- Indicate your preference for major, minor, or either in brackets next to each topic you list.
- Leave unused sections blank if applying for fewer subjects.
- List at least 6 topics in case first choices are unavailable.
